ADA and Emerging Legal Landscape

Goal: Explain how disability law is adapting to AI challenges.

• The ADA's Current Framework

- Title I: Employment discrimination.
- Title II: Government programs & services.
- Title III: Public accommodations, including websites and apps.
- Note: ADA was written in 1990 before AI but principles still apply.

Recent Federal Guidance

- EEOC Guidance (2022-2023): Employers must ensure hiring AI tools don't unlawfully screen out individuals with disabilities.
- DOJ Guidance: Algorithms used in public services must be accessible and non-discriminatory.
- Section 508 & Rehabilitation Act
 Updates: Accessibility for federal technology.

Pending & Proposed Legislation

- AI regulation bills in Congress (e.g., Algorithmic Accountability Act).
- State-level efforts such as California and New York's proposed rules for automated hiring tools.
- **Key Point:** Courts and agencies are **expanding ADA interpretation** to cover digital and AI discrimination.
