Public Comment

Approval of April 16 and May 21, 2024 Minutes

Budget & Friends of Ridgefield

While the Board of Selectpersons voted to approve the "Cultural District of Ridgefield" as part of the Friends of Ridgefield (a 501c3), Norwitt has not learned if the Friends of Ridgefield Board has provided their final approval. She will reach out.

Marketing

The ECDC allocated \$10,000 for marketing the Cultural District and the Town of Ridgefield to hire several influencers to visit and post about the Town. Morris arranged for three influencers to visit Ridgefield on three different weekends and visit different locales. TasteCT visited ACT, the Playhouse, HooDoo Brown, the CakeBox, and saw the Kicks public art exhibit in the streets. Also, Brunch with Babs will visit soon. Morris will prepare a report.

Some RHS interns handed out updated Cultural District Window clings (eg the acorn symbol) to businesses in town.

Some banners are up around town with the logo “Big City Arts, Small Town Soul” designed by Jonathan Winn and organized by Morris.

Data Collection
