FAR (floor area ratio) is the ratio of the total floor area to the total area of the lot, in square feet.

Total floor area is the area in square <u>feet of ALL floors in ALL</u> buildings measured to the outside of the exterior wa excluding attics, basements and open porches. Note: Any horizontal area of a residential building with an interior floor to ceiling exceeding 16 ft. shall be considered to have one floor per multiple of 8 ft.

An open porch has a roof but is not enclosed with screens or windows. Porches enclosed with <u>scre</u>ens or windows counted towards total floor area.

Lot coverage is the percentage which the aggregate (total) building area of all buildings on the lot bears to the area a ratio of the total building area to the total lot area.

Building is any structure which has one or more floors and a roof and is intended for the shelter, housing or enclos persons, animals or materials. Open porches with roofs count towards lot coverage.

Building Area is the maximum horizontal cross section of a building on a lot, measured to the outside of the exteri except that up to eighteen (18) inches of projections for cornices, eaves, gutters, chimneys or similar appurtenance excluded.
