Subject: Sewer Authority

Below is from the Code of Ordinances for the Town:

The Water Pollution Control Authority shall consist of five members serving four-year terms ending October 1. Initially, two members shall be appointed for two-year terms, one member for a three year term, and two members of four year terms. Thereafter one or two members shall be appointed at the expiration of each four year term. At least two members must possess formal technical training appropriate to the understanding to operation of sewer plants. At least on member shall be a member whose residence is served by the Ridgefield public sewers and one member whose residence is served by a private septic system.

The water pollution control authority shall be responsible for supervision of the town's sewer plants. The authority shall formulate and approve a fee schedule. The authority shall formulate and periodically update a water pollution for the town. Such plan shall designate and delineate the boundary of: Areas served by municipal sewerage system, areas where sewerage facilities are planned and the schedule of design and construction anticipated or proposed, areas where sewers are to be avoided; areas served by any community sewerage system not owned by the town, and areas to be served by any proposed community sewerage system not owned by the town. The authority shall determine the appropriate use of such capacity.
