Who am I?


My Name is Aiden McGrath, I am a senior at Henry Abbott Tech in Danbury, CT.

My Eagle Project is replacing a 16' by 3' bridge and improving the trail that connects the beginning of the of the Colonial heights trail with the rest of the trail.


The location of the project on Pumping Station Road
