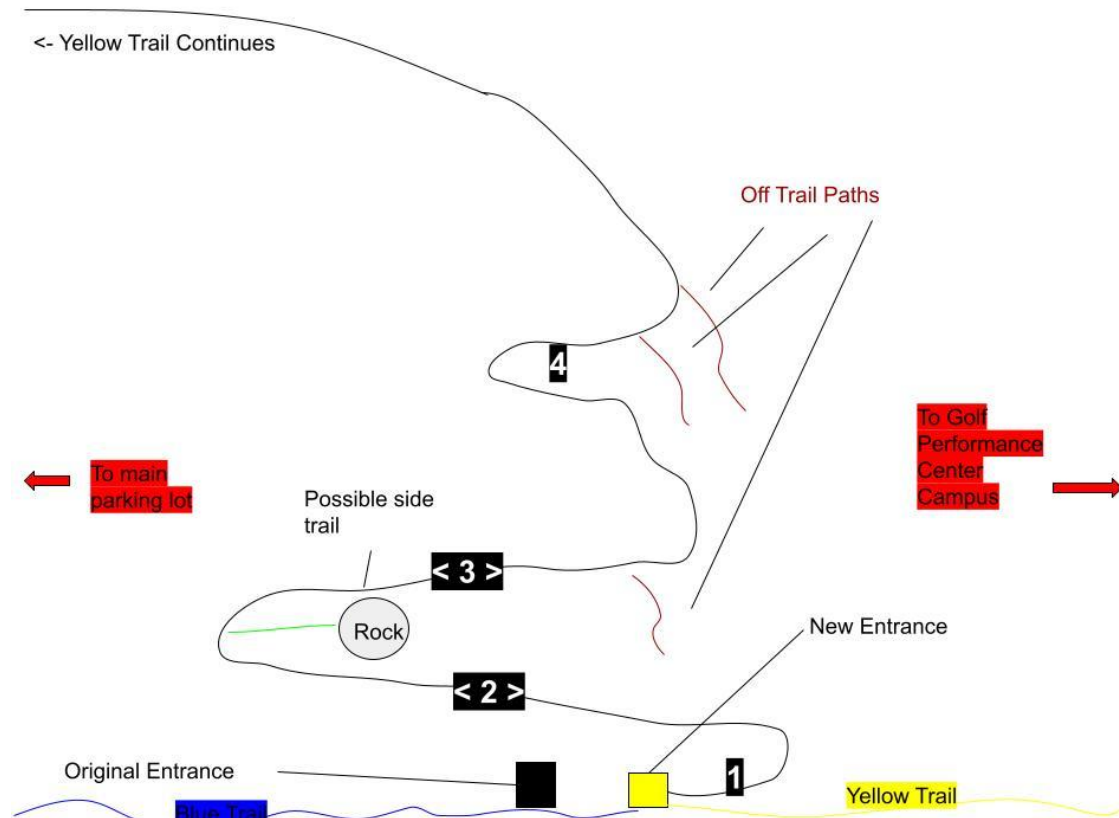


# Aldrich Park Trail Final Report
