3. ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

George Washington Highway – A citation has been issued to the homeowner at 25 Stonewall Lane. The homeowner has 30 days to respond.

Skytop Road/Land Conservancy – Mr. Coyle sent an email to Mr. Marconi requesting the unmaintained road be abandoned and turned over to the RCC in an effort to restrict illegal access.

4. OPEN SPACE

McKeon Farm

 <u>Tremson Estimate</u> – The \$1950 estimate to hydoax mow the 1-3/4 acre garden/meadow area was discussed. The RCC will need to remove metal fencing in the area prior to work beginning.

UPON motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was RESOLVED to spend \$1950 to mow the garden/meadow area.

- <u>Sign</u> Mr. Cronin offered to make a larger sign that includes the town seal and Ridgefield Conservation Commission on the sign.
- <u>Electric to shed</u> An electrical contractor quoted \$1220 to provide electric to the shed. Mr. Cronin will investigate solar power as a low cost alternative.

• <u>Tractor</u> – The McKeon Committee will meet to discuss purchase and use of the town budget approved tractor.

Wooster Work Day – June 6 – Ms. Snow and Mr. Cronin will work with the students at Pine Mountain clearing and blazing trails.

RCC Banner – Mr. Cronin will create and order the banner for use at upcoming RCC events by the end of June.

Lakeside Drive Donation – The public hearing will be held June 6th and the Special Town Meeting on June 20th.

East Ridge Trail – The trail was cleaned up by Mr. Coyle, Mr. Cronin and two volunteers last weekend. Mr. Beckenstein will contact a representative of the dog park to discuss the problem of, and possible solutions to, visitors throwing dog refuse onto the trail.

5. PLAYHOUSE GREEN EVENT – Ms. Snow asked the commission if they would like to participate in the Green Expo on July 22nd from noon to 2pm. The RCC agreed this would be a terrific idea. Mr. Bishop and Mr. Cronin offered to represent the commission at the event.
