I: Call to order

Chair Ms. Sesto called the meeting to order at 9:05P.M.

II: Discussion:

1. #2020-075-APA, 223 West Mountain Road application per Section 4 of the Town of Ridgefield Aquifer Protection Area Regulations to make a determination of a prohibited, nonregulated or regulated activity for a proposed playscape and associated sitework within State-Defined Level A Public Water Supply Aquifer Area. *Owner/Applicant: Ridgefield Academy. Authorized Agent: David Vallerie.*

Ms. Peyser briefly outlined the process of Aquifer Protection Agency application and review Section 4 of the APA regulations. She added the members have to make a determination if the activity is prohibited or a regulated activity. If the determination is made that the activity is regulated, the applicant will go through the process of registering the activity with the State.

If the determination is made the activity is not regulated there is no further discussion.

Mr. Bishop suggested obtaining information on the Aquarion wellhead.



Mr. Pilch motioned to receive the application, schedule discussion on January 14, 2021 and site walk on January 10, 2021, Ms. Miller seconded. Motion carried 6-0-0.
