Did You Know...

- ◆ That motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for children ages 1-12 years old?
- ♦ That according to a NHTSA study, 3 out of 4 kids are not as secure in their car as they should be because their car seats are not being used properly?
- ♦ That using the correct restraints reduces infants' and toddlers' chances for fatal injury by 71% and 54% in passenger cars respectively?
